He has extensive experience handling cases involving commercial vehicles and tractor-trailers and has worked with families facing sudden, life-altering loss because of preventable roadway crashes.

He has written and lectured on brain injury litigation and trial strategy, with a focus on recognizing symptoms, working effectively with medical professionals, and presenting complex medical issues clearly and responsibly to juries.
